WIKING fascination generated from both old and new moulds: Encouraged by their initial success, the traditional model makers are now unveiling the Büssing 12.000 equipped with a tarp and painted in the colours of "Deutsche Bundesbahn". Inspired by more recent designs are the VW T1 Samba bus with export bumpers and the gorgeous contemporary Magirus S 3500, which is presented for the first time as a tank trailer thanks to a newly designed driver's cab and comes painted in the colours of "Rheinpreussen". WIKING showcases true classics to celebrate the 85th year of the company's history: These

include the VW T3 van converted into a taxi, the Opel Olympia as a typical ambulance of the time and the Mercedes-Benz 250 T re-fashioned as a police patrol car. The lineup of classic vehicles is rounded out by the Magirus 235 D as a stanchion trailer truck, the Mercedes-Benz NG as a tipper trailer with "Meiller" tipper and the authentic "Keller Geister" vehicle combination with a Unimog

U 406. The second model the company launches as part of their "85 years of WIKING" collector's edition is the VW T1 (Type 2) transfigured into a "Gaststätte Bei Onkel Otto" van that matches WIKING's building cut-out sheet. The Audi Q7 rolls into the spring selection as a model fire brigade car. Making its debut in the N gauge category, the VW Tiguan enters the product portfolio as a deployment lead vehicle.

Imitating reality as closely possible, WIKING has always crafted miniature models of vehicles that can be found travelling on the road every day. Staying true to this principle, the company started out by making 1:87 models of trailers and semi-trailers engineered by "Blumhardt-Fahrzeugbau". WIKING has formulated a theme set to commemorate the wide variety of unique specimens crafted by the car body builders from Wuppertal: customers can now configure their own authentic combinations with matching colours. The traditional model makers embark on a journey into the past with two fire brigade vehicles: the Mercedes-

Benz 200/8 is launched as a mobile command vehicle, while the VW T1 enters the product line as a fire brigade van crafted from old moulds. Now ready for prime time, the majestic Lanz Bulldog with top is a throwback to an era when the associated drag rake was considered a ground-breaking accomplish-

ment. The model upgrades on the 1:87 scale are topped off by the VW Beetle 1200 convertible, which inspires memories of the 1960s with its uniquely designed flanks, and the "Rheinkraft" and "Rinnen" logistics trucks. Published under the title of "Wiking-Autoträume", WIKING's sixth book offers another collection of riveting stories about the venerable brand. The John Deere 6820 supplements the 1:160 scale.
